2020 has been a challenging year for all of us in so many different ways. We feel fortunate to be abe to go forward this year with the guidelines set forth by the City with your well-being in mind:

The City of Naples resolution requires persons to wear face coverings inside public buildings or businesses, or attending public outdoor events when it's not possible to maintain a social distance of six feet. Exceptions include children under the age of two years and persons eating, drinking or persons needing accommodations per the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Laura Burns has been passionate about the arts her entire life. With a BFA in Painting from the Savannah College of Art and Design, and as a certified decorative finisher, she has worked with elite agencies and patrons in Ohio before pursuing her master's degree in Arts Administration and Non-Profit Management. In 2007, Laura helped found the Hattie Larlham Creative Arts Program, based in Mantua, OH, a program dedicated to freedom of expression for individuals with severe and profound disabilities. She spent three years working in New Zealand as the Director of regional arts development for Creative Northland, Chairwoman for New Zealand's oldest youth theatre and as a Director of the Northland Regional Chamber of Commerce, contributing directly to arts and cultural development for the region, before relocating to Naples. Laura has served as the Executive Director of the United Arts Council since September of 2016, whose mission is to "Enrich lives and strengthen our community through the power of the arts."



Our dedicated volunteers not only provide sustenance in the delivery of meals, they also deliver the message 'we care' to each of the recipients they serve. In the past year, SVDP has helped more than 18,000 people and served over 55,000 meals through Meals On Wheels and other Society programs.



The SVDP Family Assistance Center, conference members, and thrift stores work together to assess the needs of families and provide assistance with rent, utilities, clothing, and household necessities. The Choice Food Pantry provides a variety of non-perishable food and hygiene items. Through these programs, the Society of

St. Vincent de Paul Naples provides those in need with the resources that empower them to achieve a life that is self-sufficient.

Through the donations to our thrift stores and SVDP programs such as Meals on Wheels, families are helped through hardships like illness, loss of work, isolation, and low fixed incomes. We are grateful to all those individuals who give of their time volunteering for the Meals on Wheels program, thrift stores, and financial assistance programs. We are also very grateful to those who give generously from their heart in order to help those in the Naples community through the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.
