



Her work will be cherished by all and her advocacy for fellow artists appreciated. Patsy was an amazing mother who would say her greatest works of art are her children Casey and Cheyenne. JACK MEGELA 2022 would have marked the 25th year that Jack Megela (1941-2021) exhibited his Photography at Art Fest. He will be missed. Jack was a man of character and creativity. At school age he was in sports and became an accomplished classical guitarist. Jack was a US Marine. He later was a member of the Ohio State Highway Patrol. After a degree

from Kent State, he became a Detective Sergeant. Jack's career as a Fine Art Photographer evolved from his 23 years in law enforcement investigating and photographing the scope of human calamities. He returned to Kent State to study art photography. Jack and Marianne traveled the U.S. capturing the magnificence of nature and Jack transitioned from a world of tragedy to one of tranquility. He lived with a true sense of purpose that comes from knowing he was part of something larger than himself. The STARability Foundation is like a matchmaker for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and employers who believe in an inclusive workplace. As an approved provider for the Florida Department of Education Vocational Rehabilitation (VR), we offer job readiness services and connect individuals with local employers and job training sites.

The Trailblazer Academy was launched in 2016 for individuals



with intellectual and developmental disabilities who, at 22, age out of school and face a gap in services. The Academy became our centerpiece program because of its focus on community engagement, vocational training and continuing education.

The **Junior Trailblazer Academy** serves teenagers in high school preparing to transition to young adulthood.

The **STAR Store** supports our mission through the sale of donated furniture, décor and other home goods. The store is also a vocational site, where participants make candles and other products in the STAR*Made Studio. Instructors' design guided work-based activities that enable our

Trailblazers to learn, practice and demonstrate vocational skills while providing meaningful service to our vocational partners' businesses.

Our vocational site partners provide opportunities for Trailblazers to access training and exposure to the work world.



Our instructor team is the heart of the Trailblazer Academy. Each instructor and employment specialist has unique qualifications, and they collectively have years of experience, insight and expertise working with individuals with special

needs. Instructors are provided with advanced training in vocational, behavioral and educational strategies promoting goal achievement.

PROFILE Hannah Rose Kandel ARTIST AND STAR ABILITY PARTICIPANT



annah Rose was born in 1991 and was diagnosed with PDD-NOS (Pervasive Developmental Disability-Not Otherwise Specified) in 1993. Hannah did not sleep very much, had stopped talking, and did not know where her body was in space. At that time, autism was diagnosed in 1 out of every 10,000 births and there were few resources available for families and very little awareness. Today, about 1 in 44 children are diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder.

Hannah's parents put together a multidisciplinary team and started interventions immediately. Hannah was mainstreamed for preschool and



kindergarten while also attending exceptional student education classes. She started talking when she was five years old.

When Hannah was a student at Eden Autism Florida, her parents, Dr. Joseph and Merrylee Kandel, co-founded Art Fest Naples with artist Patsy Reeves to support Eden's therapeutic services for children with autism in Southwest Florida.

After many years of special education, Hannah enrolled full time at Seacrest Country Day School, where she had an aide with her in the classroom.

HIGHLIGHTS OF HANNAH'S LIFE SO FAR INCLUDE:

- Her 2005 Bat Mitzvah. She studied for two years to become an adult in the eyes of her Jewish Community.
- Training her service dog "HoneyBun." Hannah enjoys the responsibility and says that HoneyBun keeps her calm.
- In 2012, Hannah was one of eight artists chosen by the United Nations for its Autism Awareness Stamp. Her painting, "Crazy Love," was selected as the result of a worldwide search for talented artists with autism. After this experience, Hannah began speaking at schools, rotaries, religious groups and continued to pursue her love of art.
- Hannah earned her high school Diploma in 2015.
- In 2018, Hannah attended The Marino Campus at Florida International University. The Marino Campus's mission is to prepare young adults with autism and other developmental disabilities for gainful employment, social competence, and independent living through a unique post-secondary experience. In addition, Hannah earned her certification as a Microsoft Office Specialist.



Hannah joined STARability's Trailblazer Academy in 2018 and now works as an administrative assistant there and as a STAR Made Studio assistant. Her many hobbies, include dancing, horseback riding, theater, and gymnastics. She works out almost every day to stay healthy in her mind and body. She would like to become a children's book author and illustrator and has cowritten and illustrated three books. Hannah's passion is art. Art is how she best communicates. She recently held

a successful private show in her studio for 90 guests where she also received several commissions.

This weekend Hannah Rose will exhibit her paintings at Art Fest Naples and is excited to share her art and passion with visitors of the show!

DUNCAN McCLELLAN

Duncan's love affair with glass began as a child while visiting a glass factory in Virginia. After many years and alternate creative successes, Duncan came back to that early vision and studied Glass Art, both in Venice, Italy and the US. After

thirty years of creating and exhibiting his work, he purchased and redesigned an abandoned tomato packing building in midtown St. Petersburg. *Duncan McClellan Glass* features his work and works of 60 plus artists from around the country. With his wife, Irene, a dedicated staff and a half-dozen well-behaved cats that enjoy the run of the place, Duncan continues to grow his vision of mentoring artists and establishing educational programs for the public.



PAUL ARSENAULT

A native of Montreal, Paul Arsenault grew up in Hingham, MA., where his love for the sea and travel emerged. Following his graduation from the Art Institute of Boston in 1973, he began a six-month stint as a deckhand on a research vessel. Arsenault signed off

in Florida in 1974 and began his professional painting career. With Naples as his base, he has embarked on painting trips to the Caribbean, Central and South America, Asia, the South Pacific, Indonesia, Australia, and the Mideast. Arsenault and his wife Eileen owned and operated The Arsenault Gallery in Naples for 30 years. The Arsenault's are strong supporters of community causes, especially ocean conservation, and several of the more than 31 organizations they have supported have held fundraisers at the gallery. The gallery closed this year, but Paul has no intentions of putting down his brushes. This is a chance to paint in places he's never visited, such as Zanzibar and to the island of Hawaii, where he will participate as "ship's artist" in a Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution research expedition to measure the tallest mountain in the world from seafloor to summit.


